

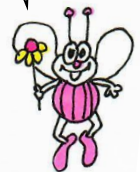

Memorial Day Hidden Picture Puzzle



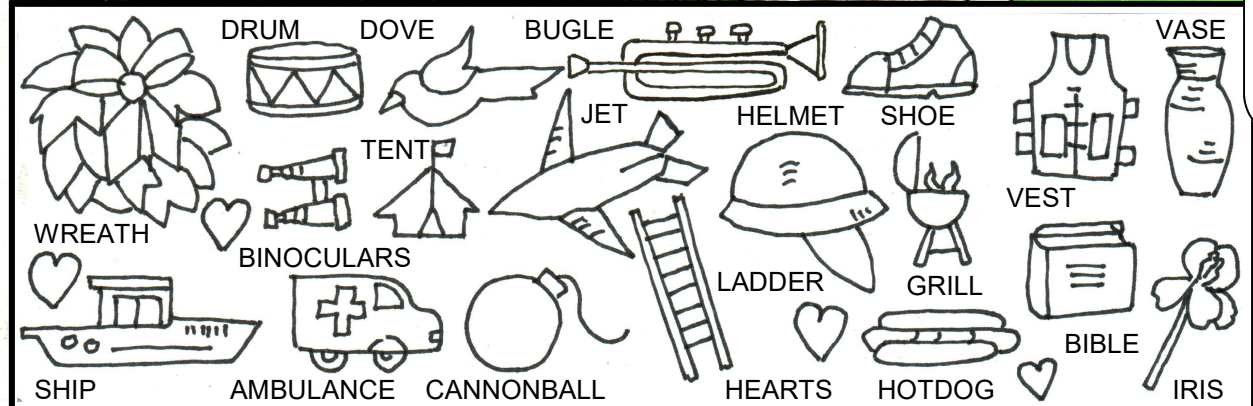
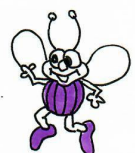
Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day. Do you know why?

Arlington National Cemetery in Washington D.C. is the most visited cemetery on Memorial Day.

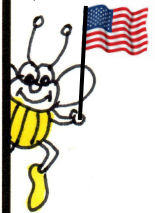

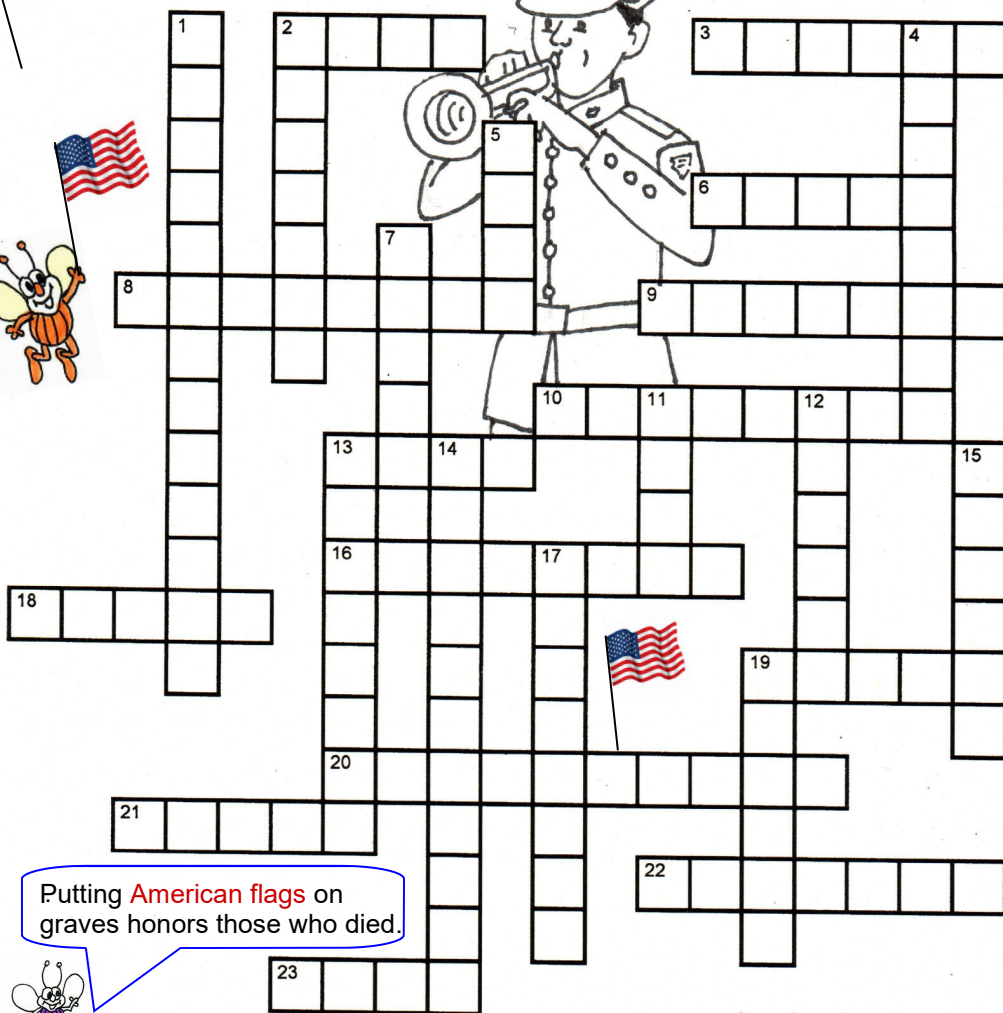


Red, white and blue are typical colors for Memorial Day grave arrangements.

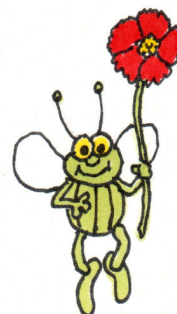
